# EXCAVATION PERMIT APPLICATION

Excavation is the operation for the purpose of the movement or removal of earth, rock, or other material by mechanized equipment or explosive device and includes, but is not limited to, augering, backfilling, blasting, boring, digging, ditching, drilling, grading, pile-driving, plowing-in, pulling-in, ripping, scraping, sub-soiling, trenching, and tunneling. Alabama Code § 37-15-2 (8)

It shall be unlawful to commence excavation for any purpose or for the construction of any building or other structure, including accessory structures, signs, and advertising structures, until the Building Inspector has issued, for any and all such work, a permit stating that the plans have been reviewed for compliance of this Ordinance. Riverside Ordinance § 37-15-2 (8)

The locating of underground utilities must be completed before operating, parking, storing, locating, or placing heavy equipment, vehicles, cranes, storage containers, or other objects on the ground's surface above underground utilities to prevent the weight of the equipment and/or object from damaging, rupturing, or severing the underground utilities and related infrastructure

Excavation Permits are not required if all of the following conditions are met:

- A building permit for the parcel in question has previously been purchased by a General Contractor (Owner exemption does not apply).
- The General Contractor has included the value of the excavation work into the total value of the contract for which a building permit has been purchased and issued.

Excavation regulations regarding natural conditions, development, retention, floodwater, wastewater, burning, nuisance, etc can be found in the City of Riverside Code of Ordinances and Riverside Zoning Ordinance.
